Veneration and Blessing of the Image

Leader: Jesus promises great graces to those that trust with childlike confidence in His Divine Mercy. Jesus said to Saint Faustina:

Leader or Volunteer: "I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: 'Jesus, I trust in You.' (Diary, 327) By means of this image I shall be granting many graces to souls, so let every soul have access to it. (570) Tell them no soul that has called upon My mercy has been disappointed or brought to shame. I delight particularly in a soul that has placed it's trust in My goodness." (1541)

All: Our Lord Jesus Christ - The Divine Mercy, we entrust ourselves to You with our whole heart, with our whole mind, and with our whole being, for the greater honor and glory of God and for the sake of all souls. We ask You to bless in a special way this Sacred Image of Your Divine Mercy.

The Image is blessed with Holy Water.

All: We solemnly enthrone this Divine Mercy Image as King and ruler of home and family. We commend our family whether broken or united, and all its members past, present and future to Your loving Mercy. May the sanctifying and healing rays of Your Divine Mercy radiate through our family into the whole world, penetrating all hearts, especially those most in need of Your Divine Mercy.

(Prayed on the beads of a Rosary)

Our Father, Hail Mary, Apostles' Creed

On the Our Father beads

All: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the Hail Mary beads

Leader or Volunteer: For the sake of His sorrowful passion,

Response: have mercy on us and on the whole world. (10x)

In Conclusion:

All: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (3x)

Reading(s) from the *Diary* **and/or Scripture** (Optional)

After the reading(s) a period of silence is observed, not breaking the Word.
