Why don't the mysteries follow the usual weekly pattern? Why aren't the Luminous Mysteries included?

The 54-Day Rosary Novena for our Nation uses the format from the traditional Miraculous 54-Day Novena given by the Blessed Mother to a young Italian girl in 1884. It begins with the Joyful, no matter what day the novena is started, and follows the repeating pattern Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious.

The Origins of the 54 – Day Novena

In Italy on March 3, 1884 (the same year Pope Leo XIII penned the prayer to St. Michael) young Fortuna Agrelli experienced an apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Fortuna was suffering from 3 incurable diseases. Doctors had classified her case as hopeless. Upon seeing Our Lady, Fortuna exclaimed "Queen of the Holy Rosary, be gracious to me, restore me to health! I have already prayed to Thee in a novena, O Mary, but have not yet experienced Thy aid. I am so anxious to be cured!"

"Child," responded the Blessed Virgin, "you have invoked Me by various titles and have always obtained favors from Me. Now, since you have called Me by that title so pleasing to Me, 'Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, I can no longer refuse the favor you petition; for this name is most precious and dear to Me. Make three novenas, and you shall obtain all."

On another occasion, Our Lady appeared to the young girl and said, "Whoever desires to obtain favors from Me should make three novenas of the prayers of the Rosary, and three novenas in thanksgiving."

Obeying Our Lady's instructions, the young girl was healed and restored to perfect health and thus began the tradition of the Miraculous 54-Day Rosary Novena. Since this novena was dictated before the Luminous mysteries were added it consists only of the original three sets of mysteries; joyful, sorrowful, and glorious. Three novenas are offered over 27 days in petition for a particular grace or blessing, followed by three novenas over 27 days in thanksgiving for prayers answered; hence, the 54-day time frame.

Our Lady of Victory, Queen of Heaven and of the Most Holy Rosary, pray for us who have recourse to Thee.
