Sept. 13, 1935: Saint Faustina Kowalska has a dramatic vision of an angel of wrath about to strike the earth. Her prayers are powerless until she is given the words we now recite in the Chaplet of Mercy. The following morning, Sept. 14, 1935, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, the Lord dictates explicit instructions on how to say the complete prayer on the beads of the rosary. (*Diary of St. Faustina*, 474-476)

My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. (*Diary*, 1541)

At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for a dying person, the pardon is the same. When this chaplet is said by

the bedside of a dying person, God's anger is placated, unfathomable mercy envelops the soul, and the very depths of My tender mercy are moved for the sake of the sorrowful Passion of My Son. (*Diary*, 811)
